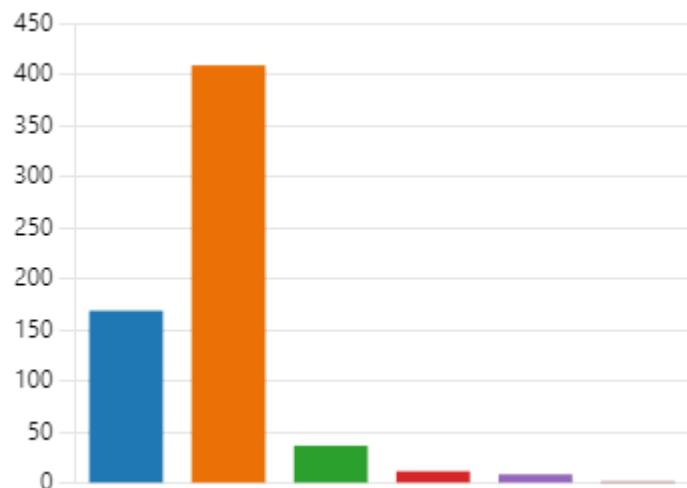

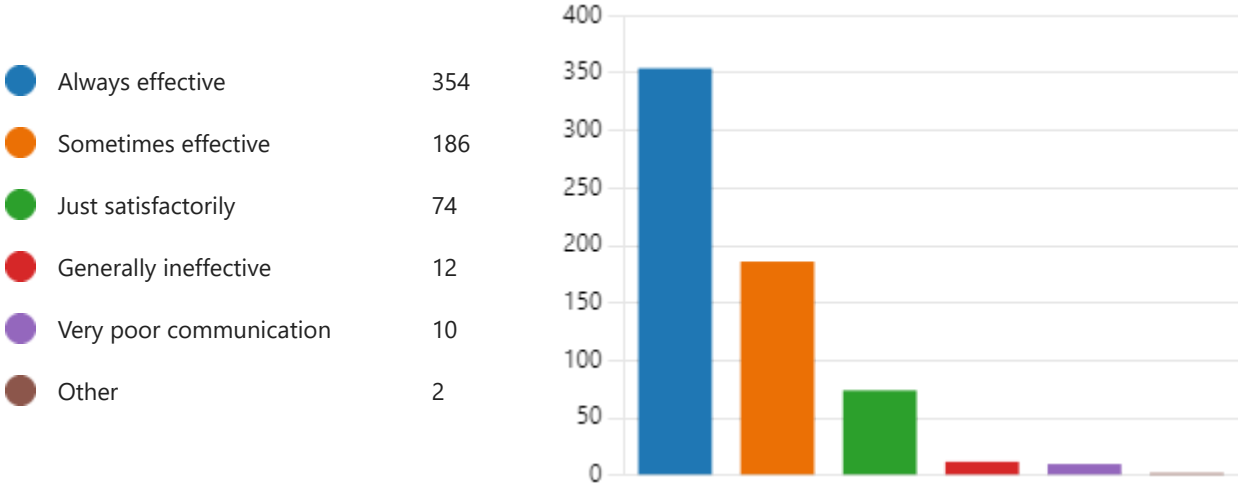

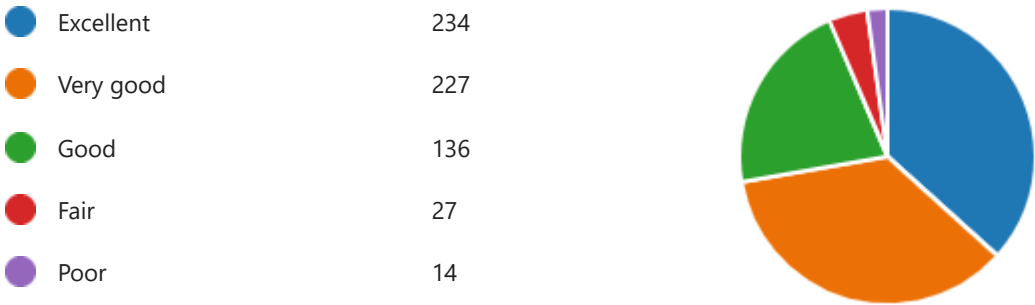

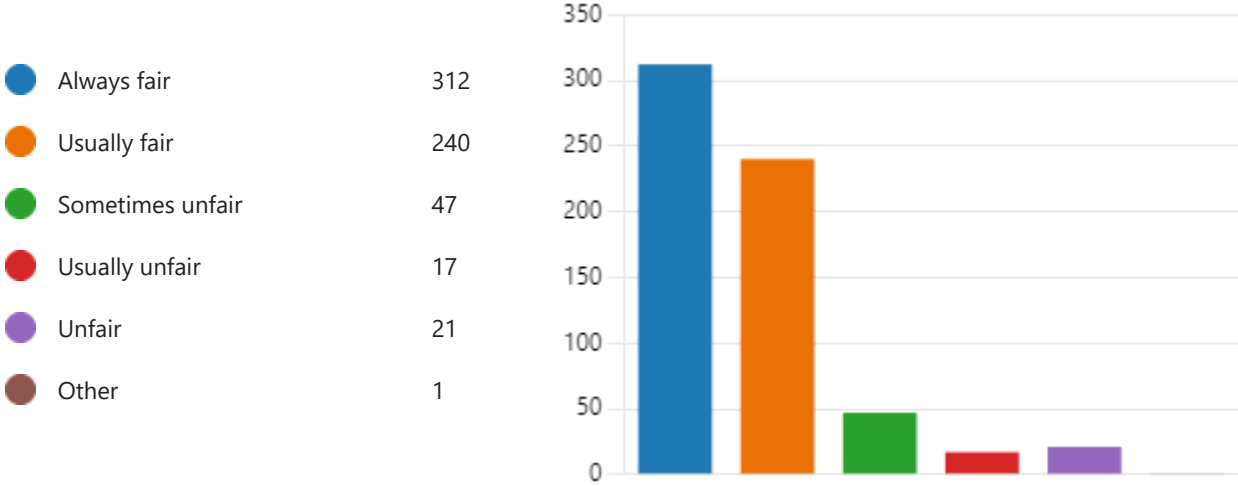
6. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

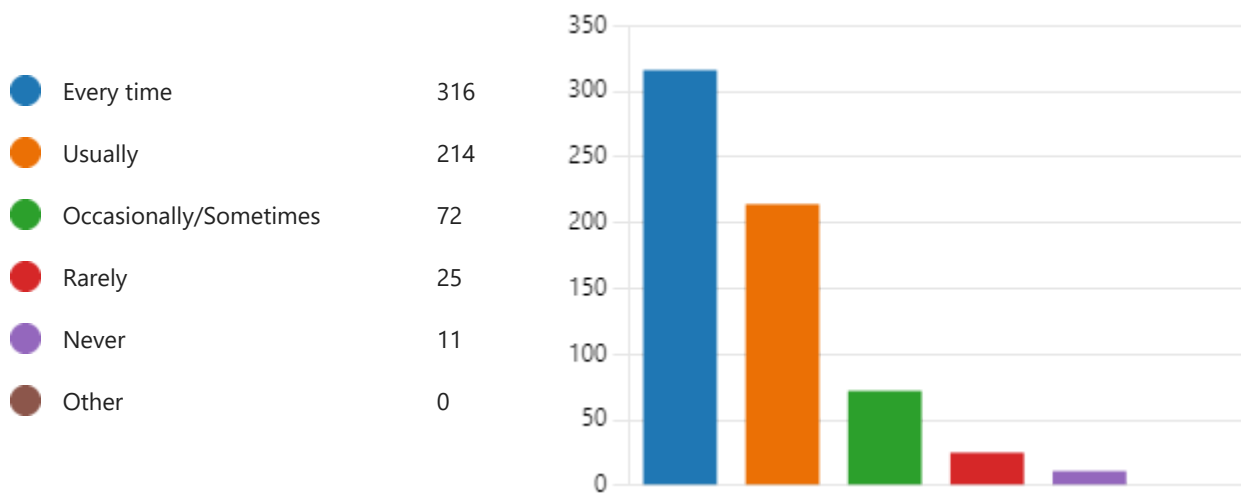

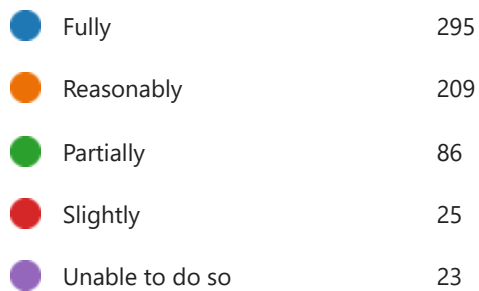

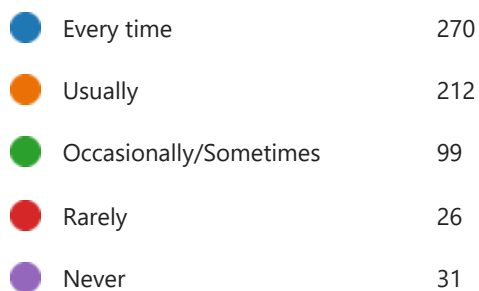

16. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.

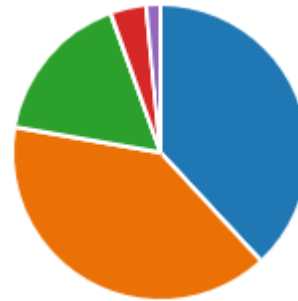

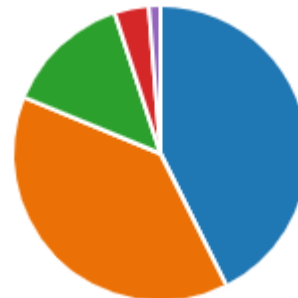

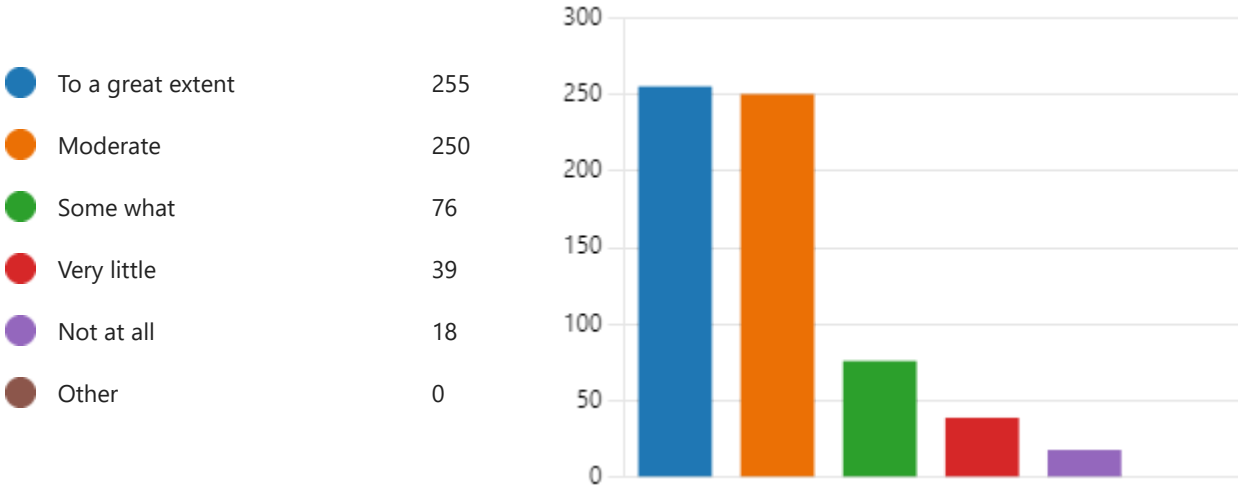


20. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities

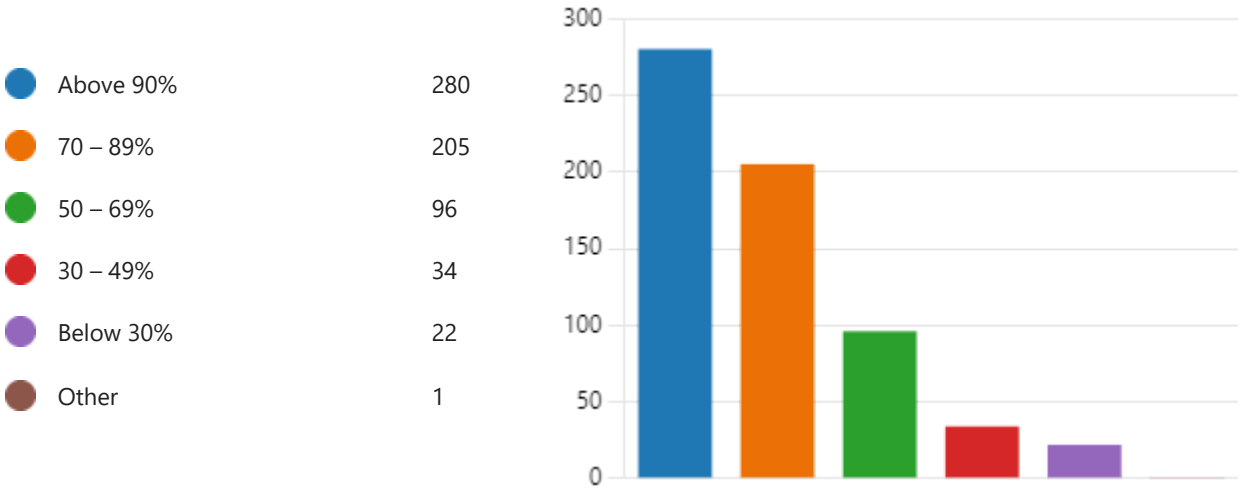
