Keeping in mind the apt adage, an industrial visit was organized for the students of final year of the Electronics and Telecommunication department on Science Day i.e. 28th of February, 2018. It was arranged for the students to visit the Giant Metrewave Radio Telescope (GMRT). Each year, Science Day is celebrated at the Giant Metrewave Radio Telescope (GMRT) observatory at Khodad on 28th feb and 1st March. Special Camp Activity Report

English Communication Skill improvement Program

BVCOEW has signed a MoU with WordsMaya Edu Tech Pvt Ltd under Capacity Building Program. The purpose of this MoU is to assess the students & arrange English Communication Skill improvement Program. Inauguration function of this program was organized on 4/01/2018.

WordsMaya is offering a Chatbot which communicates with students over face book messenger. With this test English grammar, reading, listening & oral communication skills of students were tested and report cards with grades were given to the students. In all 922 students participated in this test.

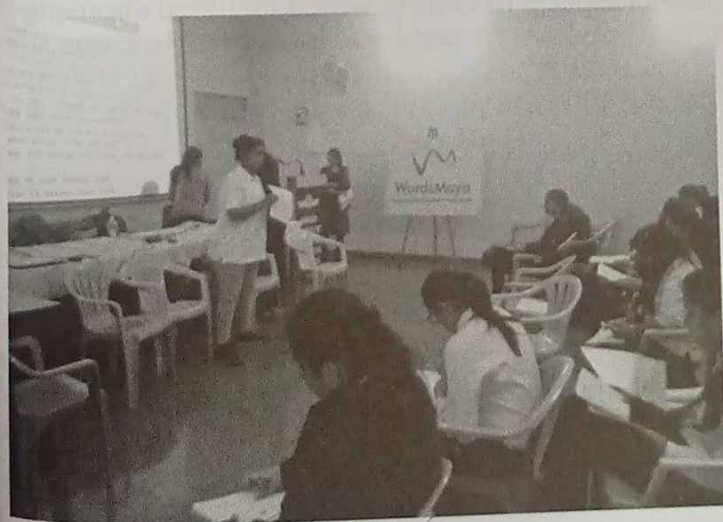
WordsMaya introduced two courses to enhance English communication of students namely

- i) 40 hrs. Basic course for SE students.
- ii) 60 hrs. Communication skills with interview techniques for TE & BE students.

Basic course consists of online lessons on English grammar, sentence formation, blog writing, creating videos, interview etiquettes & presentation skill. In all 5 workshops on introduce/known yourself, English sentence formation, Role play, Extempore, Debates & Presentation were conducted.

Communication skill with interview techniques course consists of 7 workshops of 3hrs each & online course of 39 hrs. Workshops include pre-interview preparation, speaking practice for fluency, practising personal interviews, being presentable during interviews & group discussions.

50 Students of TE & 69 students of SE have enrolled for above courses & are being trained.



Training Cell

If a child can't learn the way we teach, maybe we should teach the way they learn.

There are several innovative and alternate approaches to imparting education. An often-found phenomenon is that students are far more perceptive and imbibing towards newer concepts when discussing among themselves, rather than being guided by an external trainer. The general observation in this respect is that students feel an enhanced level of comfort among themselves and tend to learn with greater interest and intensity in the company of their peers.

Under this observation, a Capacity Building Program was developed for the students, by their own seniors, under the guidance of the Training and Placement cell and staff co-ordinators. The idea behind developing the entire program was to motivate students through guidance from their excelling seniors and create an atmosphere of overall learning and growth. Through their seniors, students could also be made adept about the most relevant technologies and industry requirements, along with gaining value lessons on time and resource management, confidence building and other crucial factors.

The main objective of the Capacity Building Program was to make younger under-graduates aware about the nature and magnitude of challenges they would be looking forward to as they progressed towards graduation, while ensuring their empowerment with tools necessary to successfully face and overcome these challenges. Engineering under-graduates often tend to be highly involved in pursuing curriculum-based academics, leaving them lagging on other vital components of a well-rounded and dynamic professional life. This program was established as an eye-opener for the younger students to realize the fundamentals of employability, apart from maintaining a good academic score-card. Centered around technical and non-technical aspects of the recruitment and selection process of any company, the Capacity Building Program served as the fundamental block for creating employable and viable professionals out of zealous and diligent students.

The fourth-year student trainers were segregated into groups classified on the basis of the subject matter covered. These groups were:

- **Attitude4Aptitude**

Aptitude round is the preliminary round in the selection procedure for any job, internship or project. Hiring companies or organizations keep the highest passing threshold to filter out the majority of the appearing crowd, thus ensuring toughest scrutiny in aptitude rounds. While the aptitude round is easier on the technical turf, testing only the very basic fundamentals involved in mathematics and science, this might be the trickiest step in the selection procedure. This group, including were responsible to make students conscious about the difficulties of the aptitude round and making them adept enough to crack it.

- **Coding Geeks**

Coding is arguably the most popular and relevant skill today. As Information Technology, Computer Science and Electronics engineers, coding forms the backbone of the students' professional future and hence their comfort and proficiency with programming is crucial. To address this need of industry and to strengthen the students' basics about different aspects of coding, the Coding Geeks group was formed. The team comprised of student trainers covered various aspects of coding which included choosing the appropriate programming language, developing algorithms, syntax and logic intricacies to name a few. Different modules of a program such as variables and data-types, data structures, looping statements were also discussed, along with hands-on practice and innovative exercises to develop strong logic building and problem solving through coding.

- **Technovision**

The students of a stream as technically centred as engineering are expected to perform best in the technical stream of any project. Therefore, recruiting organizations are bound to test applicants on their technical skills and prowess. Among the swirling excess of newer technologies and technical advancements, any student will certainly find oneself in a dilemma. The key here is to consolidate technical basic ones learns in the very beginning of branch specification. In order to demystify all doubts students might face with the technical aspect of the selection process or otherwise, the Technovision team discussed various possible methods of testing technical skills along with techniques to solve them. Many essential resources were also shared with students for further preparation.

- **Team You Can**

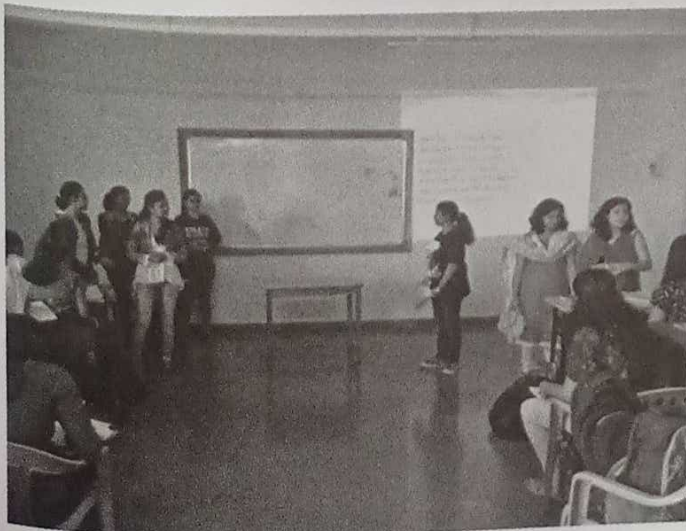
Finishing and finesse are pivotal factors for interest development in a potential employee. Due to this

very reason, any organization looking for selecting new hires subject potentially strong and shortlisted candidates through HR rounds. A person highly skilled in technical minutiae might miss out on a legit employment opportunity for lack of some inter-personal and vocational skills. The members of Team You Can, including trained the students to grasp the factors under consideration in the HR round of selection process. Several situational questions were discussed with the students, where their presence of mind and agility, along with emotional quotient were tested in an interactive and conducive atmosphere.

• F-square

The ultimate aim of an engineering undergraduate is to be placed in the job one desires. There are multiple factors that come into play when applying for a job with a particular organization. While students as applicants might have a generalised approach when applying for jobs in various companies, this might not be the best of choice. The F-square team was focussed at helping students realize the specific requirements of companies and the way in which these should be approached. This team categorically guided trainees about the different profiles of companies that they might face for placements and individually covered the company specifics for certain chosen case studies.

The entire Capacity Building Program covered all aspects of placement procedures and professional futures post completing graduation in the following five sessions. By the end of these sessions, the trainees were both enriched and positively motivated to work hard and aspire for greater professional goal.
