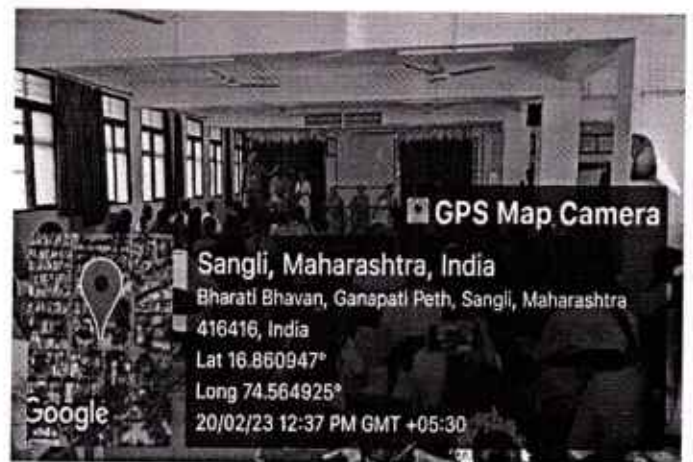
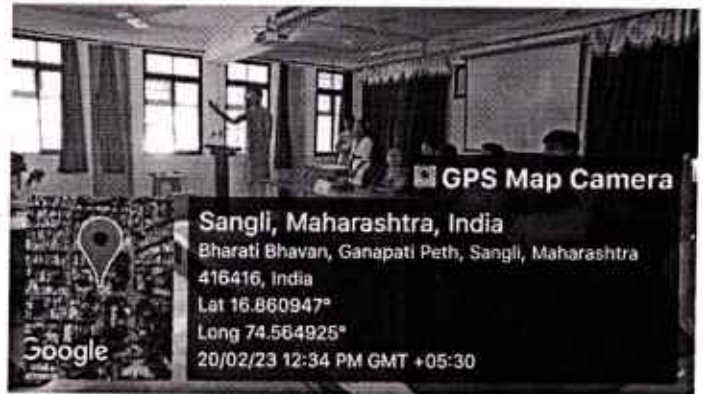
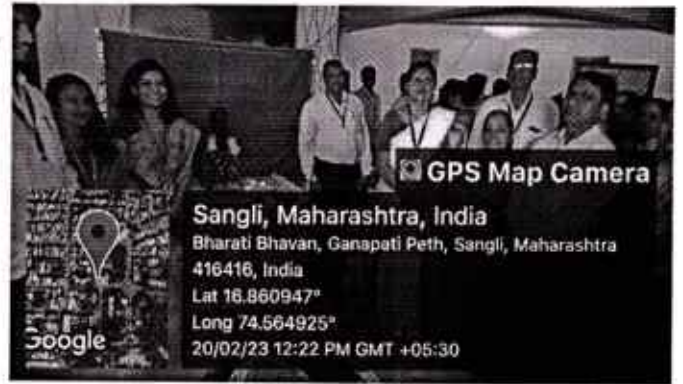
## **Shiv Jayanti Report**

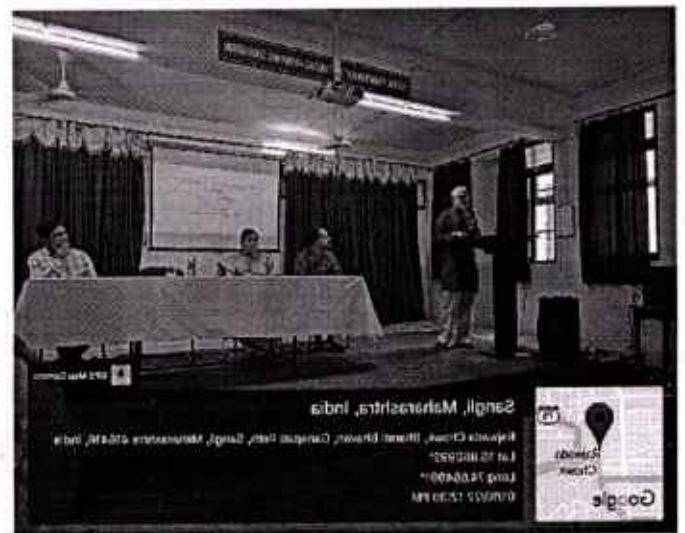
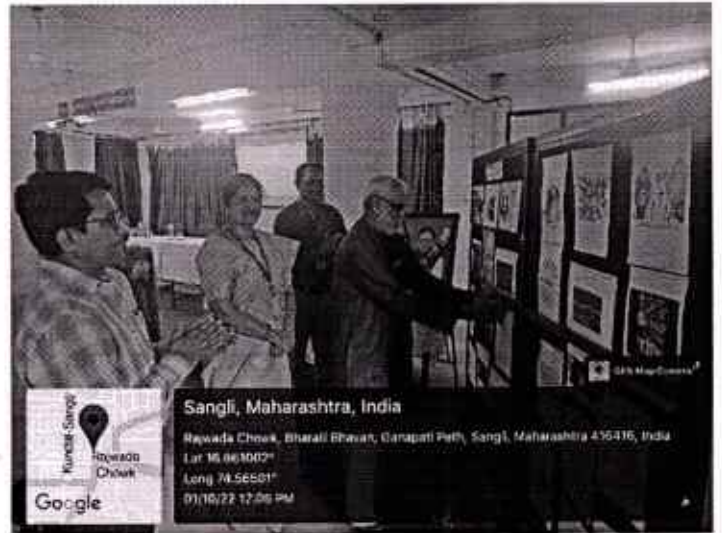
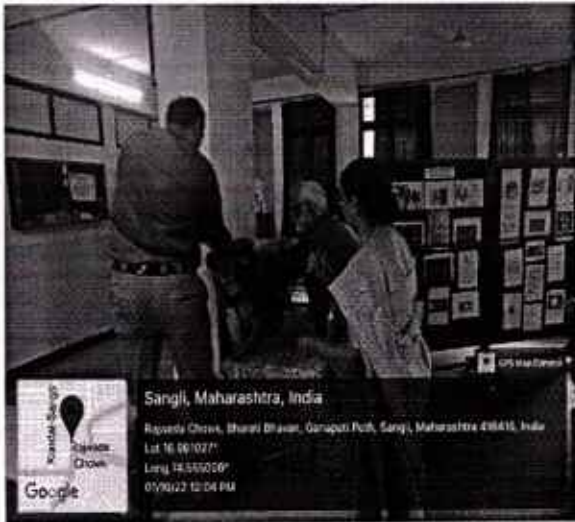
The program was organized with the objective to encourage feeling of national integration, peace, affection and communal harmony among the students.

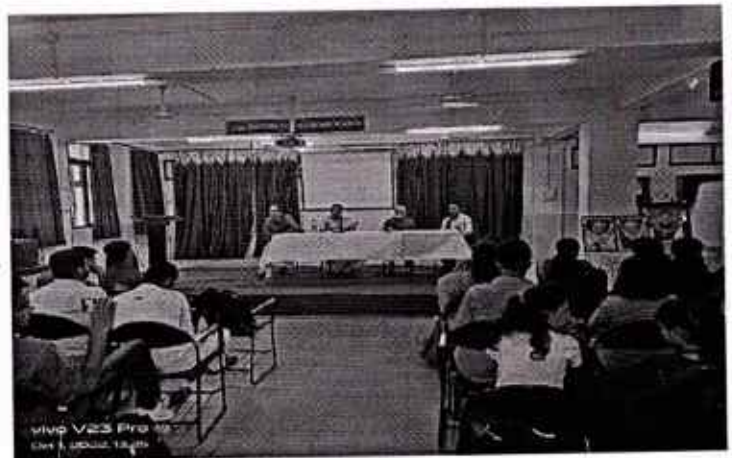
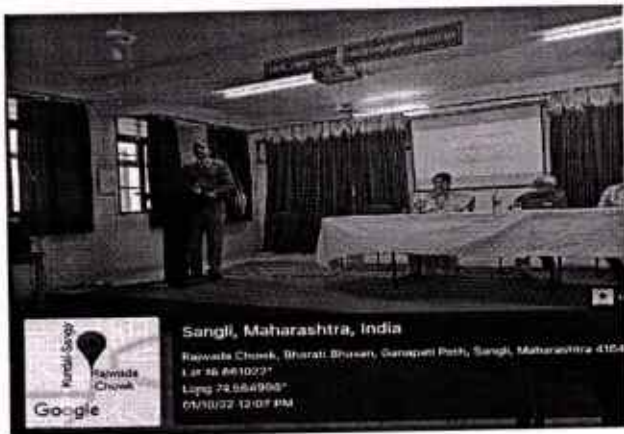


### **Report Human Rights Day**

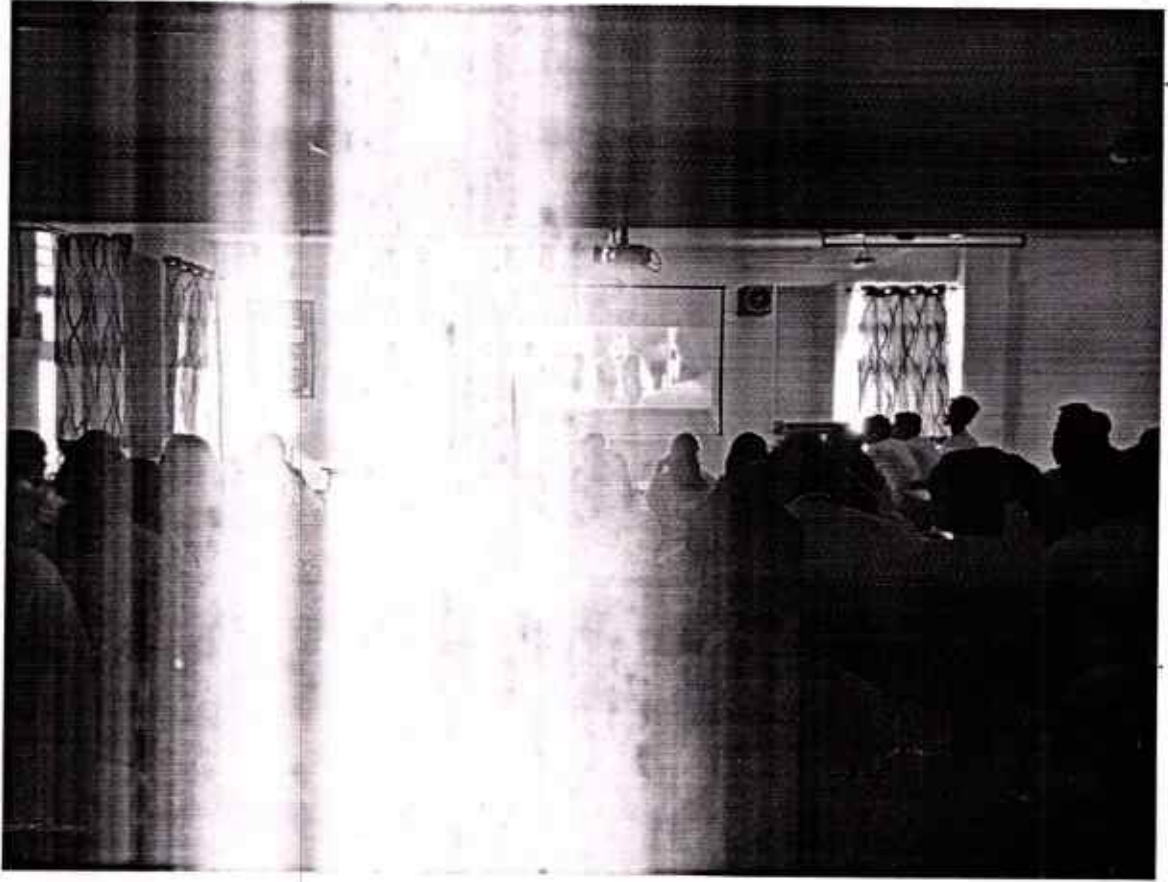
## Shaheed Diwas

## Fresher Party 2k18



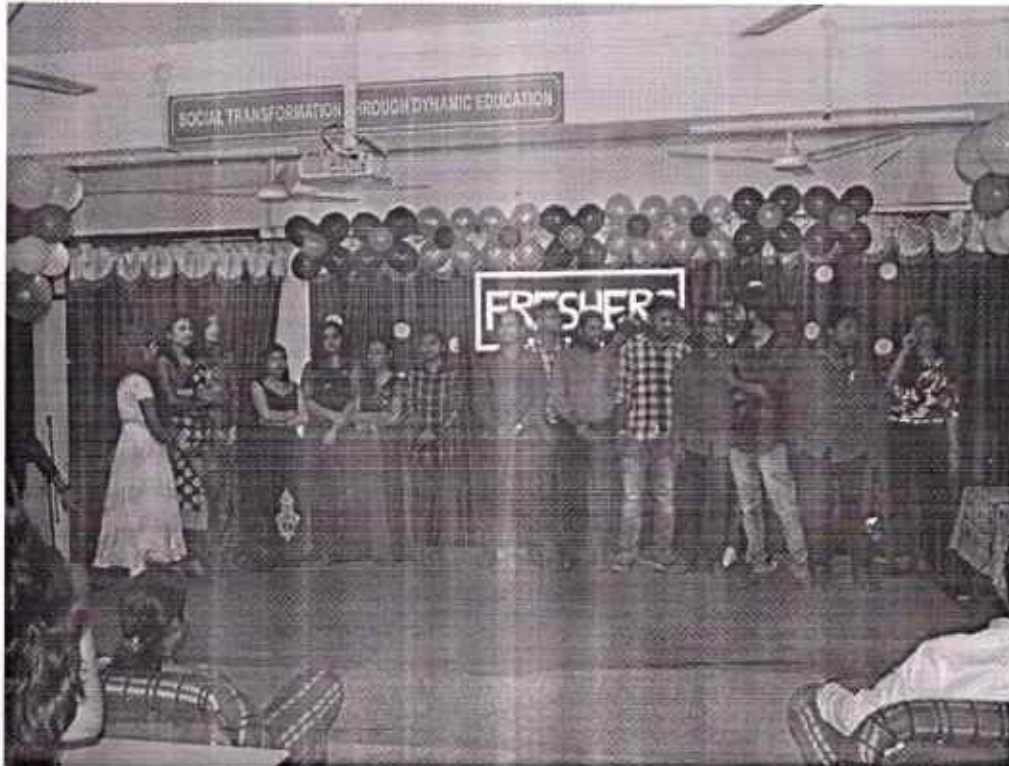

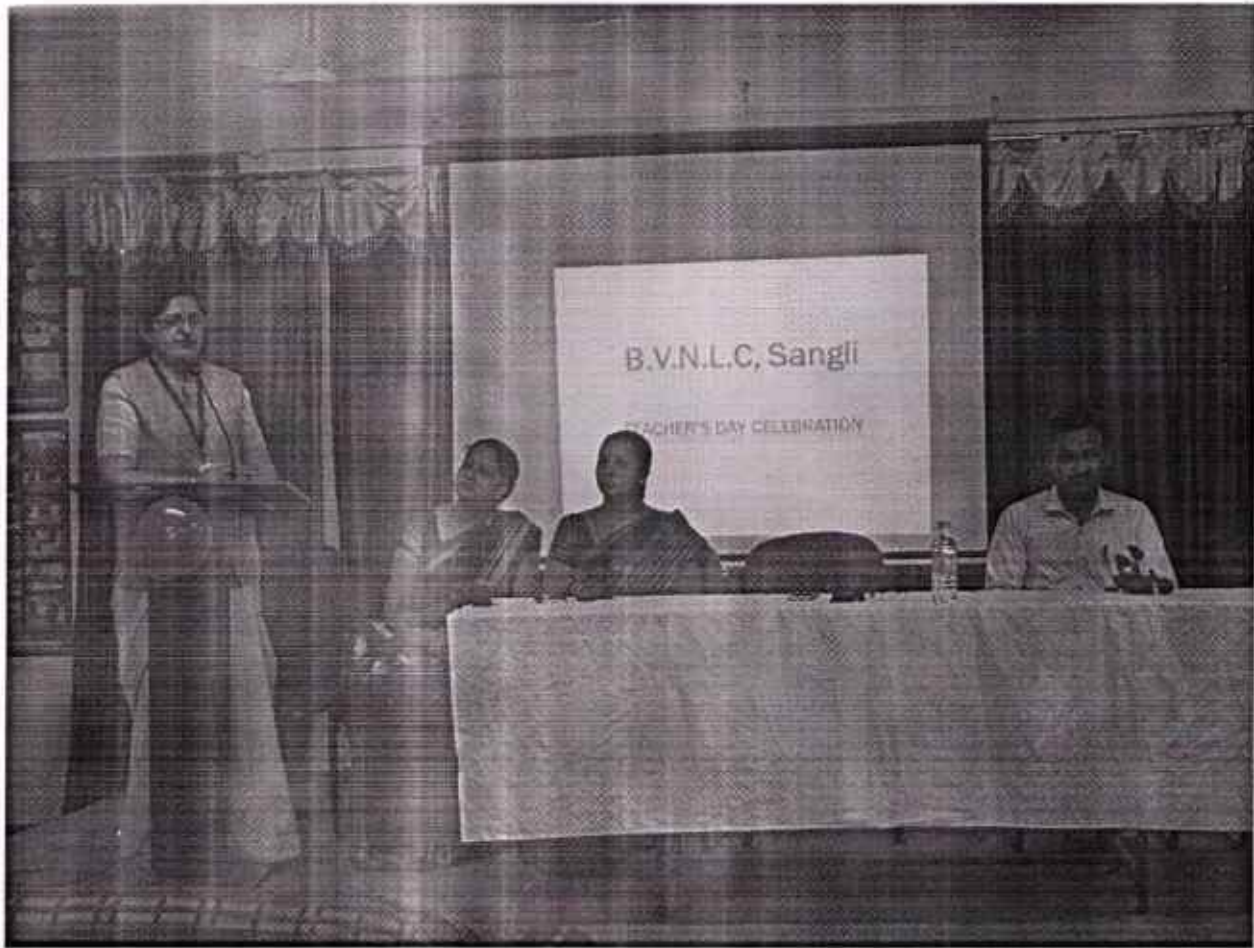

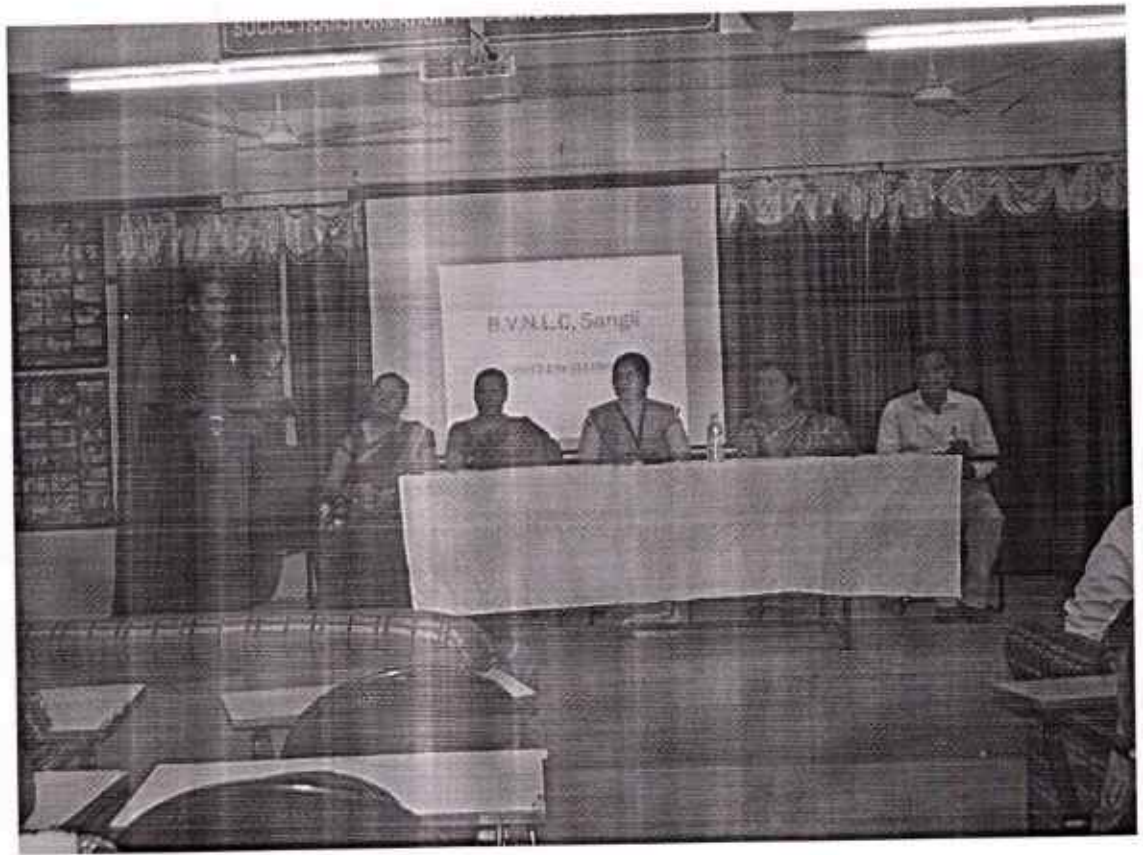
## Teachers Day Celebration 18-19

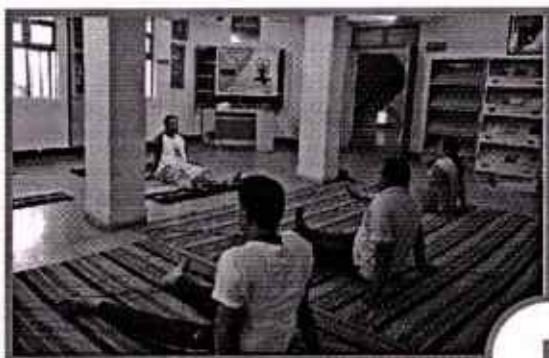
