2nd round- Presentation and justification

1. Selected participants would be given opportunity to present and justify online their critique in English or Hindi or Marathi
2. Each participant will get 15 (10+5) minutes for online presentation.
3. The panel of judges would cross examine the participants
4. Result will be declared on the basis of scores of first and second round

General guidelines -

1. Participants can refer to laws, ideologies, theories, judgments, study reports, commentaries, policies, real incidences etc in their written submission and presentation.
2. No defamatory words or language is permitted in written or oral presentation

Interclass Client Counselling Competition

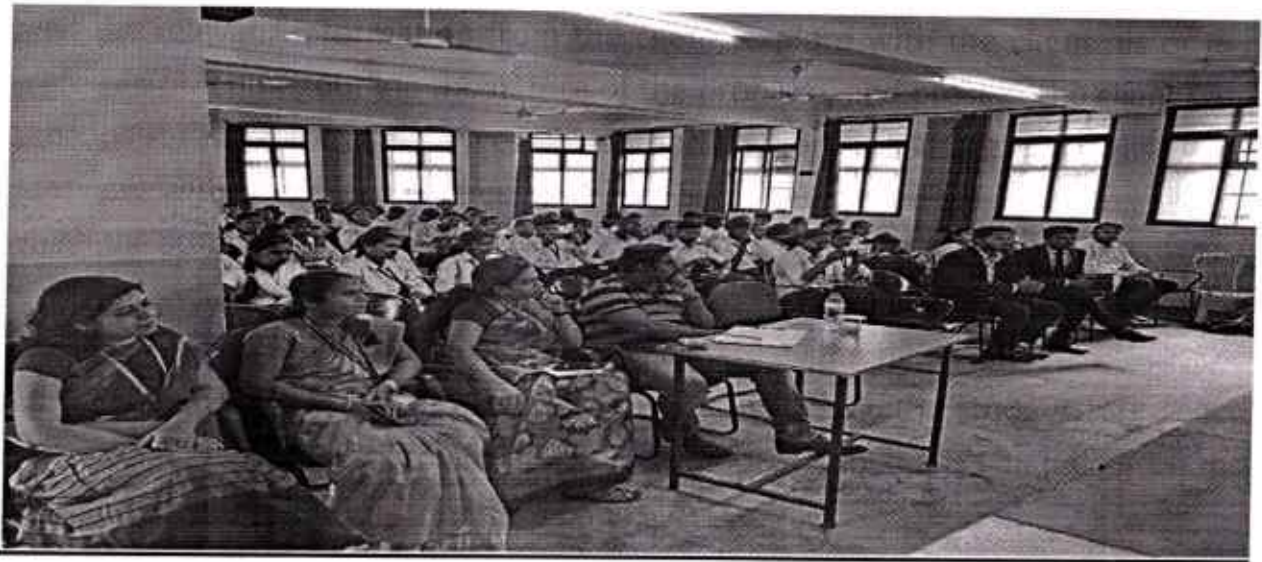
College organizes various activities every year to develop students' professional attitude, knowledge and all round development. **Client Counselling Competition** is one of the activity which shows an actual communication between client and counsellor.

Our college, Bharati Vidyapeeth's New Law College Sangli has organized the Interclass Client Counselling Competition Wednesday, 18th May 2022 at 12:15 pm. The purpose of the Client Counseling Competition promotes greater knowledge and interest among law students in the preventative law and counseling functions of law practice. It also encourages students to develop interviewing, planning, and analytical skills in the lawyer-client relationship in the law office. Interviewing and advising are a significant part of most lawyers' work. Too often, it is assumed that lawyers have the listening and questioning skills needed to conduct an effective interview. Regrettably, not all lawyers possess these skills. The Competition provides an opportunity for a valuable educational and cultural interchange between students and law teachers.



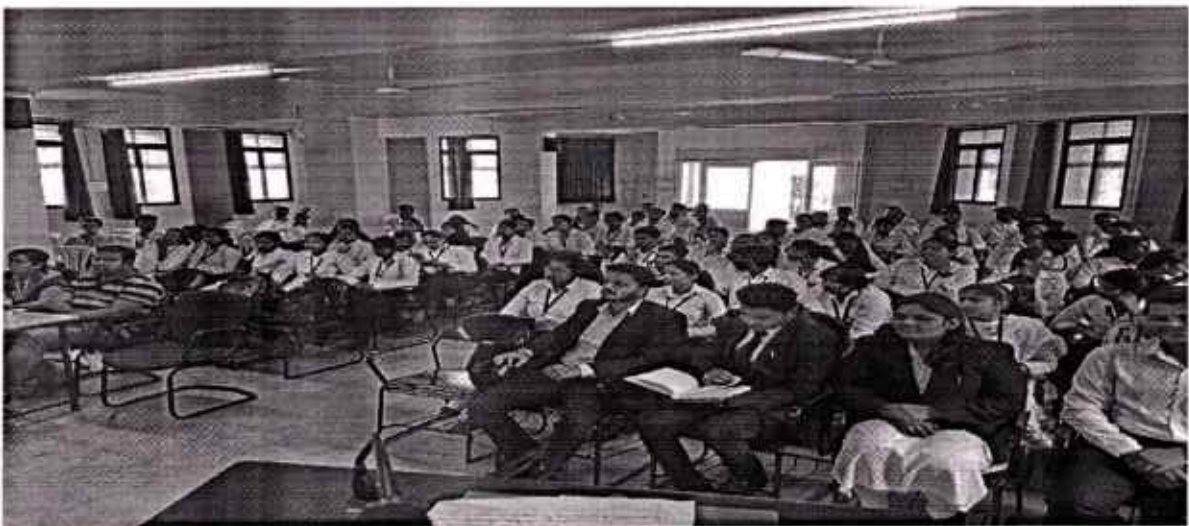
Nature of the Competition

The Competition simulates a law office consultation in which two law students, acting as lawyers (attorneys/solicitors/legal practitioners), are presented with a client matter. The students are given a brief written memorandum that identifies the general nature of the subject-matter of the client's problem before the interviews are held. The students conduct an interview with a person playing the role of the client. Students are expected to elicit the relevant information from the client, explore with the client his or her preferred outcome, outline the nature of the problem, and present the client with a means (or range of alternatives, if appropriate) for resolving the problem. The interview with the client is then followed by a post-consultation period during which the students, in the absence of the client, analyze the interview and discuss the legal and other work to be undertaken. The interview and post-consultation period last a total of 45 minutes. The students are evaluated by a judge. Once the judges have completed their evaluation of the interview, the students are called back in and the judges provide a brief critique of the team's handling of the consultation and post-consultation periods.
