



Bharati Vidyapeeth's New Law College, Sangli Annual Report 19-20

The college was established in the year 1997 with the object of providing legal professionals and social engineers to fulfill the dream of '*Social Transformation through Dynamic Education*' of Hon'ble Dr. Patangrao Kadam, Founder of Bharati Vidyapeeth, Pune and the Chancellor of Bharati Vidyapeeth University, Pune. The main objective behind establishment of this college is to provide opportunity to rural masses that were outside the stream of education by providing quality legal education for Social transformation.

Initially in 1997, the college commenced the Under-Graduate Three Years Law course (LL.B.). The Five Years Law Course was started with the recognition of Government of Maharashtra and approved by the apex body Bar Council of India in 2001-02.

From the very inception, the college is serving the society with the Vision:

"Quality Legal Education for Professional Competencies and Social Transformation"

I am happy to let you know that the college has been accredited with NAAC, 'A' grade and while moving towards excellence we are taking every possible effort.

In academic year 19-20, Admission process was conducted as per CET Cell Government of Maharashtra. Every year, the college conducts skill enhancing short term courses like Cyber law, Proficiency in the use of English, Yoga and Advocacy skill with active support and guidance from the Department of Adult, Continuing Education and Extension Work, Shivaji University, Kolhapur. This year, the total admissions to these courses are nearly 90. In this academic year we have commenced a course in Forensic Law and Criminology.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:

To prepare the students to face the challenges in the competitive world, the college organizes different co-curricular activities. The students are encouraged to participate in Moot Court and Mock Trial and other competitions held at National, State and Local level.

This year our students secured First position in State Level Moot court competition and also National Level Client Counseling Competition and also at Avishkar Research Poster Competition.

EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:

In Extra-curricular activities, We arrange, 'Vidhi Pushpa' law lecture series, wherein Hon'ble Judges, renowned advocates, academicians, social and political activists are invited to deliver lectures. This year also we arranged 6 lectures under Vidhi pushp law lecture series.

1. This year in association with Bahai Academi Pachagani ,we have conducted seven days course for enhancing Abilities, Skills and Healthy Attitudes, a course titled ASHA.
2. This year we have started a new course "Soft Skill Development with Holistic Approach" for First year student with a view to develop soft skills in students.
3. This year, we have organized, Nirbhaya Sakhi: Symposium on Women Safety where in nearly 100 girl students actively participated.
4. With clinical approach we have conducted one day workshop on "Medico Legal Care for Victims of Sexual Violence" for students of seven law colleges.

Our upcoming programs include National Competitions and National Seminar in which students from various law colleges are in India are participating.

3 RESEARCH CONSULTANCY AND EXTENSION

The College always encourages the faculty members to enhance teaching learning skills along with the theoretical inputs through participation in national and international workshops, seminars, conferences.
